

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The community of Leeming Senior High School, through its School Board, has chosen to have a designated School Uniform for the following reasons:

- 1. Enhances a sense of belonging, equality, and community spirit.
- 2. Separates school from leisure time, focusing students' efforts on learning.
- 3. Prepares students for the expectation of post-school employment.
- 4. Assists the school to identify unwelcome strangers.
- 5. Promotes a positive image of the school by ensuring a standard of presentation for all students.



The Uniform Shop is run by the P&C. Sale proceeds go directly towards school projects that benefit all students.

Shirts, Jumpers and Jackets, Pants, Shorts, Skirts and Dresses



All official Leeming SHS branded uniform items are permitted, however, please note that the sports polo is only for use during physical education – students should change into and out of their uniform during the allocated time at the start and end of the physical education lesson.

Students may also choose to wear plain white t-shirt or long-sleeve t-shirt underneath their uniform, provided no stripes or logos visible.

No hooded items of clothing are permitted.

All pants, shorts, skirts, and dresses should be an appropriate length for a school environment. No denim or fleece tracksuit pants are permitted.

Hats, beanies, and head coverings

Leeming SHS encourages students to cover up when outdoors, and students are permitted to wear a hat or cap of their choice outside of classrooms. The Uniform Shop sells caps for \$18.00. These should be removed before entering any building in the school. Students are permitted to wear beanies on the way to and from school but should remove beanies on arrival to school.

Students who are required to wear head coverings for cultural or religious reasons are permitted to do so.
