SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ACADEMY SPECIALIST PROGRAM

Students and families accepted into one or more of the Specialist Programs do so on the understanding that this is an ongoing commitment from time of acceptance until the end of Year 10. School-initiated withdrawal processes can be found in the Specialist Programs Policy.

The Science and Technology Academy Specialist Program is a four-year Department of Education approved specialist program (Years 7-10). It provides extension and enrichment opportunities to students identified as being academically capable and gifted. A limited number of places are offered every year through a rigorous selection process which includes a series of tests to assess higher-order thinking skills, literacy, and numeracy.

As a student of the Science and Technology Academy Specialist Program (STA) you will engage in enriching in-class and co-curricular programs that foster your interests and abilities. Students explore aspects of contemporary science and are encouraged to explore and follow their special areas of interest in STEM. Our students gain access to opportunities through the STA program partnerships with Scitech, CSIRO Lab, Murdoch University and other institutions.



Students are encouraged to practice and test what they are learning with the support of our highly skilled teachers. The program has an inquiry-based approach to teaching and learning and focuses on the practical application and synthesis of knowledge to equip students for the evolving modern world, and to ensure students reach their full potential.

JAPANESE SPECIALIST PROGRAM

Japanese Specialist Program is the only Language Specialist Program in WA Department of Education schools. Students can be part of an innovative and challenging languages program designed to prepare them with essential communication skills, an intercultural capability and an understanding of the role of language and culture in human communication.

We offer a student-centred approach which recognises that not every student learns at the same pace or in the same way. Students are encouraged to reflect on their strengths, weaknesses and set personal goals for their languages studies.

We recognise the importance of connecting with a native Japanese speaker and through our collaboration with Kobe University, we have a dedicated Japanese Language Assistant in class full time. This arrangement allows students opportunities to engage in language practice with a native speaker.

Students can also participate in the two-week immersion program at school with a visiting Japanese high school in Term 1 and an online exchange program with students from Hiroshima Kokusai Gakuin High School in Term 2.



JAPANESE SPECIALIST PROGRAM



Students engaging in the four-years Japanese Specialist Program at Leeming Senior High School will acquire valuable language proficiency and cultural understanding, equipping them with skills that can enhance future opportunities in a range of fields, such as tourism, international business, diplomacy, teaching, translation, interpretation, editing, proof-reading or engineering.

ACADEMIC EXTENSION PROGRAM

A school-based Extension Program

The Academic Extension Program (AEP) is a school-based extension and enrichment program in English, Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS) for academically oriented students. It offers a unique opportunity for advanced learning accommodating each student specific talents. The AEP program is designed to provide a supportive environment where your child can collaborate with like-minded students, creating a rich academic community.



Your child will be immersed in challenging coursework that stimulates critical thinking, enhances analytical thinking skills and fosters a deeper understanding of the topic of study.

Ultimately, by participating in this extension program, your child will not only cultivate a passion for learning, but also thoroughly prepare for future academic endeavours and professional success.

ACADEMIC EXTENSION PROGRAM

Fostering and facilitating students' curiosity and problem-solving skills. Focused on collaborative and inquiry-based learning driven by students. AEP students are guided through a process that encourages interaction and questioning between peers to broaden their perspective and understanding of the world.

WE ARE A TEAM!

This program is made up of talented students with a passion for learning and a desire to question the world around them. While their individual achievements help to secure their place in the program, their involvement in a community of learners helps to foster strong friendships with like-minded peers in safe and supportive environments.

AEP teachers meet regularly to share expertise, provide feedback on student progress and to coordinate activities across the key learning areas. A close monitoring of students ensures an efficient individual mentoring and engagement.

AVIATION STUDIES



Aviation courses are available to students in Years 9-12. In Lower School, students are offered the opportunity to gain insight into what Senior School Aviation studies might look like through Introduction to Aviation and Flight School courses.

In Senior School (Years 11 and 12) students can choose between ATAR and General Aviation studies.

The curriculum covers areas of study such as aerodynamics, air traffic control, navigation equipment, calculations for take-off and landing, air law and aviation weather codes. The courses combine theoretical lessons and practical lessons in one of our six flight simulators.

RELATIONSHIPS AND PARTNERSHIPS

We liaise with flying organisations at Jandakot Airport to offer opportunities to our students to get flying experience and pursue their Recreational Pilot License in their free time if they wish to.

One of our ATAR Aviation students was awarded the 2023 WA Minister's Aviation Scholarship Award and is planning to pursue a career in Commercial Aviation.

AUSTRALIAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION

The Australian Medical Association has partnered with Leeming Senior High School to create a nursing hub on our school grounds for the delivery of Certificate II, III, IV courses in Nursing and Medical Support Services from 2025 onwards.

MURDOCH FLEXITRACK

Our Year 11 students can apply for entry into the Murdoch FlexiTrack High program for Year 12. This is a direct university entry pathway that runs during Year 12 and provides successful students direct entry to undergraduate courses at Murdoch University.

SCITECH AND CSIRO

Our Science and Technology Academy students benefit from our partnership with the SCITECH and CSIRO who organise specialised visits and workshops for our students.

JANDAKOT AIRPORT

Aviation students benefit from our partnership with Jandakot Airport, with access to specialist tours and workshops as well as special rates for flying hours.

LAW SOCIETY OF WA

Our Academic Extension Program and HASS students benefit from the participation of the school in the Law Society of Western Australia's Mock Trial Competition. This provides them with unique practical opportunities to immerse themselves in the trial process and better understand the Western Australian legal system while networking with other schools and lawyers from across Perth.

FOCUS ON PERMAH

Positive Emotions, Engagement, Relationships, Meaning,
Accomplishment, Health

As a PERMAH school, we work explicitly in class to promote positive emotions, student engagement and improve relationships. Integrated into the curriculum, we help students find meaning and focus on their accomplishments and health. Enriching their learning experience and contributing to the overall well-rounded development and flourishing of our students.



Positive Engagement: We promote activities that enhance students' understanding of the importance of being in the present moment. Activities and lessons are designed to stimulate their curiosity, interest, and creativity to intrinsically motivate them and positively impacting their wellbeing.

Positive Emotions: Students engage in a range of in-class and house group activities that focus on creating daily habits that stimulate a positive outlook. Through targeted months such as Mindful May and Grateful November students develop a great understanding that they can have an impact on their mood and outlook in life.

Positive Relationships: Students develop an understanding of the importance of creating strong relationships with their peers, family, and community and the impact this has on their sense of belonging. Students are explicitly taught how to develop strong connections through compassion, kindness, empathy, and teamwork, and how these relationships enhance their sense of wellbeing.
